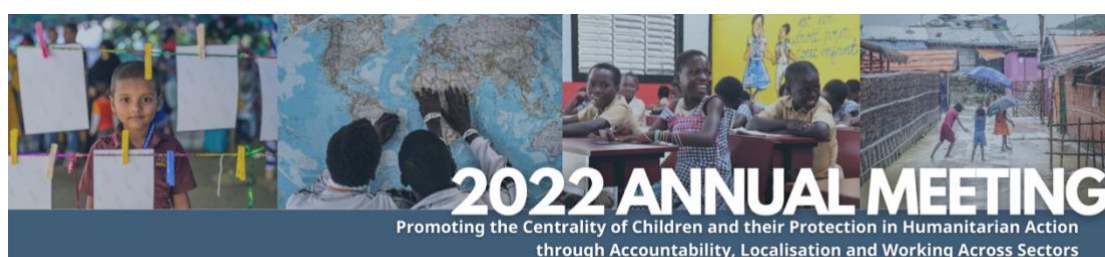
AN OVERVIEW OF THE ALLIANCE 2022 ANNUAL MEETING

Introduction of 2022 Annual Meeting

The Alliance for Child Protection in Humanitarian Action (the Alliance) organized the 2022 Annual Meeting for Child Protection in Humanitarian Action over a virtual platform from the 20th to 22nd of June. The Annual Meeting focused on accountability, localisation and working across sectors. It was an interactive space for practitioners from around the world to share their experiences, challenges and successes across these areas.

This year's theme was selected to inform and drive discussions on the transformation of the [Alliance strategy](#) into a concrete and ambitious strategic plan, which would be done by exploring the strategic priorities of the Alliance and how they interrelate and reinforce each other; conceptually and practically.

The Annual Meeting serves as an opportunity for humanitarian actors to come together and exchange knowledge and experience, while networking with other agencies, academics, policy makers and donors. This year's annual meeting hosted 539 participants from 179 unique organisations across the world.
