AN OVERVIEW OF THE 2023 ANNUAL MEETING FOR CHILD PROTECTION IN HUMANITARIAN ACTION

Introduction of 2023 Annual Meeting

The Alliance for Child Protection in Humanitarian Action (the Alliance) organised the 2023 Annual Meeting for Child Protection in Humanitarian Action on Zoom Events from the 12th to 15th of June. The Annual Meeting focused on the centrality of children and their protection through research, policy and practice. The meeting served as an interactive space for practitioners around the world to share their calls to action, as well as their lessons learned and successes in prioritising children and their protection across the humanitarian system.

This year's theme was selected based on input from over 200 survey respondents who predominantly selected **“centrality of children and their protection”** as the top priority for discussion at the 2023 Annual Meeting, along with accountability to children, prevention, and learning and development.

The Annual Meeting serves as an opportunity for humanitarian actors to come together and exchange knowledge and experience, while networking with other agencies, academics, policy makers and donors. This year's annual meeting hosted 1,210 participants, 950 of which joined individual sessions during the meeting, from 386 unique organisations representing 147 countries and territories across the world. As well as two in-person Participation Hubs in Nigeria and Iraq as a pilot for enhanced local actor engagement.
